SCHEDULE 40 - PUBLIC STREET LIGHTING SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all governmental customers and contiguous state and county installations for street and highway lighting purposes.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Alternating current, either multiple system or series, or in combination, at the option of the District.

MONTHLY RATE

The rate for this Service shall consist of two parts, Energy Charge and Facility Charges, as follows:

All Energy	6.10¢ per kWh
Facility Charges	1/12th of the Annual Facility Charge

The Annual Facility Charge (covering the cost of operation, maintenance, and fixed charges) shall be twelve percent (12%) of the District's investment in property and equipment used solely for street lighting purposes, such as lamps, ballasts, relays, photoelectric cells, fixtures, brackets, mast arms, conductors, poles (wood and metal), conduit, standards, control equipment, transformers, etc. This investment will be adjusted at each year-end for additions and retirements at original cost made during the preceding year and the Customer will pay 1/12th of this Annual Facility Charge each month during the subsequent year. The District will provide the Customer with an annual report setting forth the adjustments.

METERING AND UTILIZATION

Dusk-to-dawn lighting service will be provided. Where metering is impractical, consumption will be calculated at the rated capacity of the luminaire plus appropriate losses, based upon 4,300 hours annual use.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Service hereunder shall be pursuant to a Special Contract which may provide, among other things, for a minimum monthly charge.
