

**PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF COWLITZ COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**SCHEDULE DDR-1 – RESIDENTIAL SERVICE**

**(Low-Income Disable Citizen Discount Rate Level 1 – 5% Discount)**

**APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to all domestic uses in single-family residences, individual apartments or small farms, supplied through a single meter and one Point of Delivery; provided that equipment and installations for space and water heating shall be subject to approval of the District.

**BASIC REQUIREMENTS**

1. The Customer must occupy the subject premises and have been signed for service as a Cowlitz PUD residential electric customer for not less than the past 12 consecutive months.
2. The Customer must provide proof of a disability:
  - Qualify for special parking privileges under RCW 46.16.381(1) (a through h) or are a blind person as defined in RCW 74.18.020(4), or
  - Earn an SSDI income, or
  - Provide a physician’s certification that they are disabled, handicapped, or an incapacitated person as defined under RCW 71A.10.020 (3) or any other existing state or federal program.
3. Annual gross household income is:

1 - 2	\$22,065 - \$25,743
3	\$27,795 - \$32,428
4	\$33,525 - \$39,113
5+	\$39,255 - \$45,798

4. The Customer must meet the requirements listed in the Low-Income Disabled Citizen Discounted Rate Eligibility Guidelines, as required by the District.

**CHARACTER OF SERVICE**

Secondary voltage; single-phase, or three-phase as available.

**MONTHLY RATE**

Basic Charge:

Single-Phase	\$6.65
Three-Phase	\$8.75

All Energy	6.27¢ per kWh
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The Basic Charge recovers costs which are similar for all residential customers, regardless of the amount of electricity used including, meter and meter reading (whether manual or automated), processing and mailing of a bill and infrastructure to deliver the electricity to individual customers
