SCHEDULE SDR-1 (LEVEL 1 – 10% DISCOUNT)**

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

Applicability

Applicable to domestic uses in single-family residences, individual apartments or farms, supplied through a single meter and one Point of Delivery; **provided** that equipment and installations for space and water heating shall be subject to approval of the District.

Basic Requirements

1. The Customer must occupy the subject premises, must be age sixty-five (65) or older and have been signed for service as a Cowlitz PUD residential electric customer for not less than the past 12 consecutive months.

2. Annual gross household income is:

Persons in HH	Gross HH income
1-2	\$14,000 - \$21,000
3	\$17,600 - \$26,400
4+	\$21,200 - \$31,800

3. The Customer must meet the requirements listed in the Low-Income Senior Citizen Discounted Rate Eligibility Guidelines, as required by the District.

Character of Service

Secondary voltage; single-phase, or three-phase as available.

Monthly Rate

All Energy 4.61¢ per kWh

Minimum Monthly Charge

The Minimum Monthly Charge for Electric Service hereunder shall be \$8.00 for single-phase service, or \$12.50 for three-phase service.
