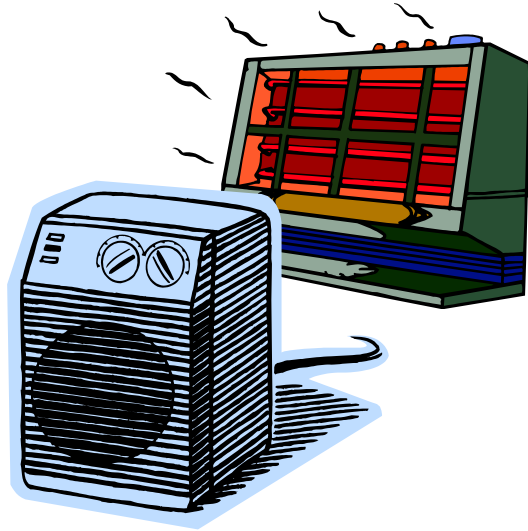


Shopping for a Portable Electric Heater?

These tips will help you save money and energy, while staying comfortable and safe.



- Most electric space heaters are 1,500 watts, and all 1,500-watt electric heaters produce the same amount of heat - and use the same amount of electricity - regardless of cost, brand name or style.
- Any 1,500-watt portable electric heater will cost less than 10 cents an hour to operate (at Cowlitz PUD's residential rate of 6.60 cents/kWh).
- An electric space heater can help you feel more comfortable, but it won't save you money unless you turn down your central heating system and use the space heater in just one room.

- ✓ **Important:** You can purchase an effective, lightweight, safe, 1,500-watt UL-rated electric heater for under \$40.00 at many local stores.
