SCHEDULE 40 - PUBLIC STREET LIGHTING SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all governmental customers and contiguous state and county installations for street and highway lighting purposes.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

From dusk to dawn daily, controlled by a photoelectric control or time switch to be mutually agreeable to the Customer and District.

MONTHLY RATE

The rate for this Service shall consist of two parts, Energy Charge and Facility Charges, as follows:

METERING AND UTILIZATION

Where metering is impractical, monthly kwh consumption will be calculated at the manufactures rated consumption of the luminaries including losses, based upon 4,300 hours annual use. Prompt maintenance, including relamping as needed, of District owned street lighting equipment will be the responsibility of the District.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

If it is necessary to extend District distribution facilities to provide service to new street light installations, the District’s line extension policy (EN-2) will apply.

Costs for minor relocations of District street lighting facilities to accommodate street improvement projects will be borne by the District. Otherwise, the costs for relocations of District street lighting facilities at Customer’s request will be borne by the Customer.

If District street lighting facilities are removed at Customer’s request, a discontinuance charge consisting of original cost, less depreciation, less salvage, plus removal cost will be made.
